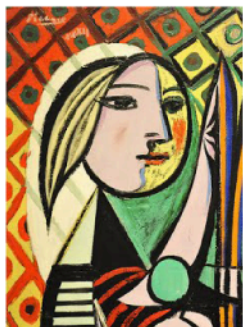

Printmaking with Picasso

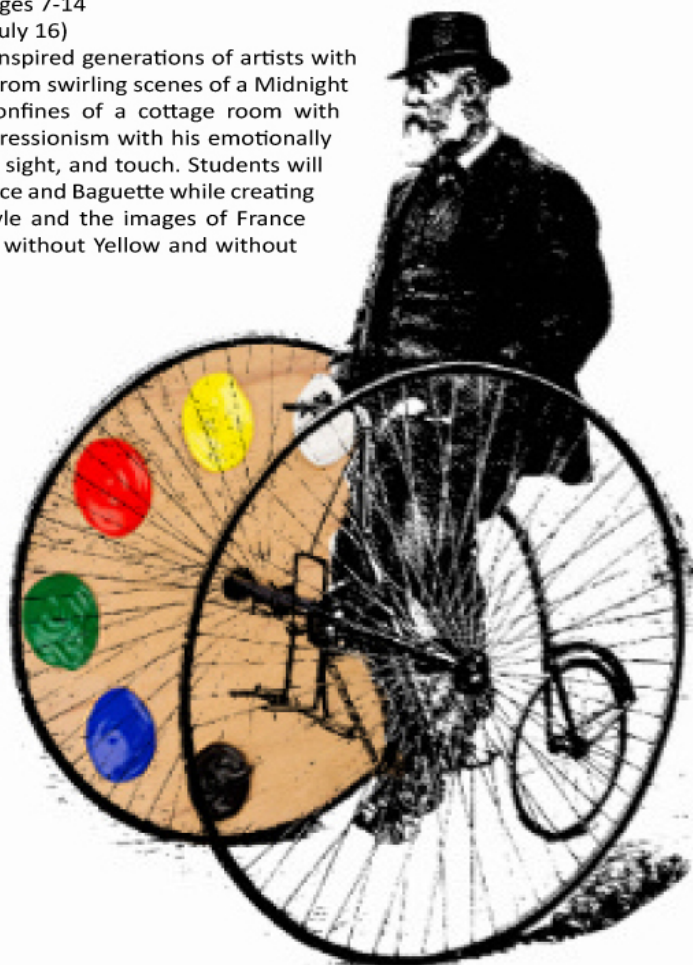

Make a stunning window glass mosaic for your home! Design your own mosaic image on a 11"X 14" framed glass, review basic techniques and learn to think about composition: position of glass, pattern, and movement within design, as well as how to use a glass wet saw. Take advantage of this unique opportunity to work on a larger scale mosaic artwork with instructor Mary Alexander! Cottage Calligraphy and Illustration Series: Mixed Media and Surfaces

with Steph Wilson, Designer and Calligrapher

Mondays, August 5 and 12, 6:30-8:30pm, for ages 12-Adult

In this more advanced "Cottage Calligraphy" workshop instructor Steph Wilson will cover a variety of materials and mediums. Students will discuss the historical context and importance of Calligraphers and "Sign Makers", and review "Modern Hand Lettering" styles. Explore lettering techniques and discover which styles work more effectively on smooth, rough, textured, patterned, or other surfaces. Students will finish with a hand lettered sign on wood, metal, or other material, reflective of traditional methods, but with a creative "contemporary sensibility". *All materials are provided including an oil-based sharpie and board for final project. Instructor will discuss options for students who may wish to bring a specific object to work on.

EUROPEAN REALISM: Methods and Materials in OIL

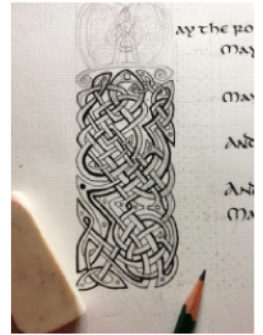
