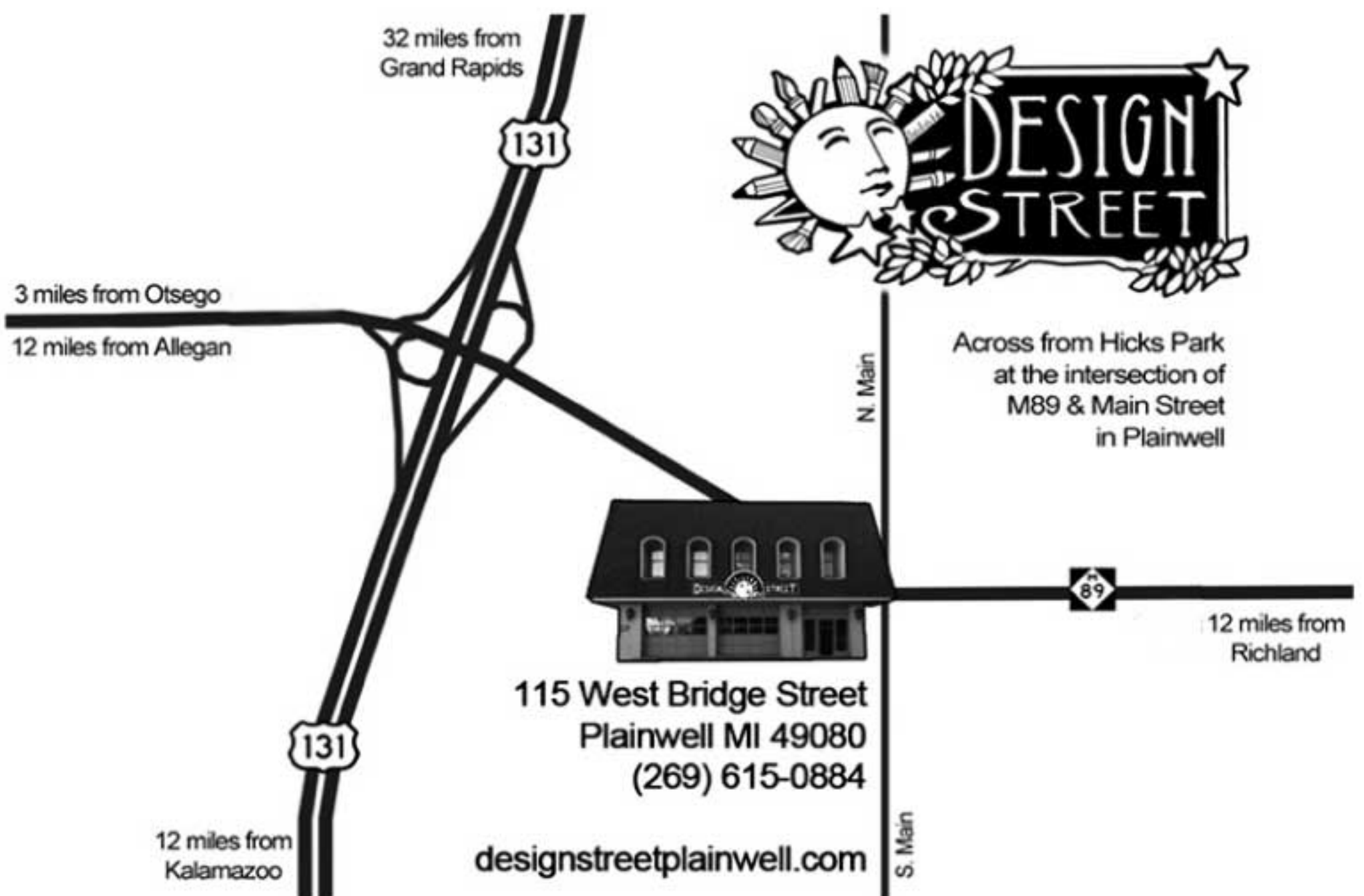

Registered students who make a withdrawal request up to one week prior to the class or workshop start date will receive a full refund.
