

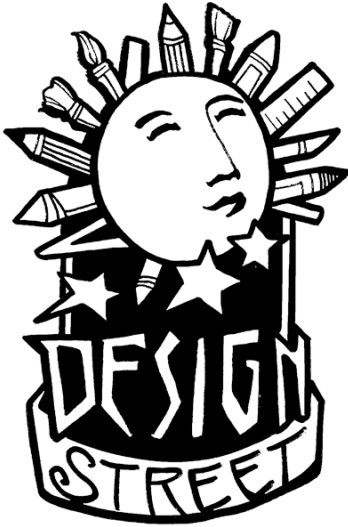

### **Scholarship Guidelines**

Scholarship funds are limited. It is possible that not everyone who applies will receive financial assistance. In order to provide the most effective assistance, scholarships generally cover 50% of an art class or art camp fee. Scholarships are tuition waivers, which must be used in the designated term and year. Separate applications are required for each term. Scholarships may be applied to one course selection only. Applicants must pay material fees when needed.

### **Application Instructions**

All applicants must submit a completed application with recommendations from teachers, counselors, community, or religious representatives. Recommendations should indicate the applicant's financial need, motivation, and ability.

Return completed application, along with recommendation letter, to Rachel Hopkins at Design Street prior to completing class registration and a minimum of 30 days prior to the start of the art class, workshop or art camp.
